

Wisewire Spanish 1 – 4.6: Los adjetivos descriptivos / Descriptive Adjectives

In this lesson –aligned to ACTFL standards– students **will apply knowledge of vocabulary related to colors, demonstrate understanding of placement exceptions with descriptive adjectives, examine and apply the concept of reinforcing adjectives, identify proper usage of the comma in Spanish writing, and examine the concept of art as a way to express feelings through Doris Salcedo's sculptures.**

This lesson has five sections:

- Introduction: includes the goals to be achieved and a video that shows the Spanish vocabulary to be learned. Students are challenged to infer the meaning of each new term.
- Instruction: contains complete vocabulary and grammar themes that use an interactive glossary. Videos provide images and audio allows students to listen and practice to correct pronunciation. Encourage the students to use a self-recording tool to improve their oral skills. Videos should be used for review as frequently as possible. This component also offers thought-provoking Culture sections, which consist of interesting facts students will learn about Spanish-speaking countries: their food, their music, their customs, their history, their art, their music, and their literature.
- Practice (Exercises) and Review (Test Preparation): each lesson has two sets of question sections that provide the students with practice to reinforce the learning process. It also includes a self-recording tool to practice pronunciation.
- Quiz: after the activity section, students may take a 5-question quiz to test retention.

It also includes two videos that support the teaching of the vocabulary and the grammar of the lesson, one bilingual and one in Spanish. Beginners and advanced worksheets complement this lesson.

Additional Materials

- To fully complete the instruction process, students will need access to a recording device.

Los adjetivos descriptivos / Descriptive Adjectives

Vocabulario

Today, we are going to learn new words, phrases, and expressions to describe color.

- **More and more colors.** You already learned several words to describe color. Here you will find some more descriptive adjectives meaning color and shades—**anaranjado/anaranjada** (orange), **rojo/roja** (red), **morado/morada** (purple), **rosado/rosada** (pink), **marrón or color café** (brown), an expression you already used to describe hair color, and **gris** (gray). Since they end in a consonant, the last two colors, **marrón** and **gris**, have the same form for the feminine and the masculine.
- **Two special hues.** Let's imagine now that you want to describe something made of gold or just something golden. You will need to use the adjective **dorado/dorada** (golden). And if you need to describe a silver piece of jewelry, a coin, or even the moon? Then you may need to use the adjective **plateado/plateada** (silver).

Now that we learned even more words for colors, how can you use them?

Watch the vocabulary section of the video only. Listen to the Spanish vocabulary words. After you listen to a word, repeat it aloud. Then, write the English meaning next to the Spanish word in your notebook.

In this Grammar section, you will review the usual placement of descriptive adjectives, and will learn about a new group of descriptive adjectives that are placed differently with respect to the nouns they modify.

- **Descriptive Adjectives Usual Placement.** A few days ago, you studied some descriptive adjectives and you learned that their usual place in the phrase is following the noun they modify. For example:
