

## **Wisewire Spanish 1—Independent Study—5.7: *Mi cuarto ideal* and *Redacción: Así es mi cuarto ideal***

This lesson has been designed to provide students with an opportunity to integrate the vocabulary, grammar, and culture concepts previously acquired: **furniture, personal items, possessive adjectives, prepositions, the verb “hay,” and the two-way influence of Puerto Rico and EEUU**. It also provides an opportunity for researching and writing, and covers the Connections, Comparisons, and Communities ACTFL standards.

Students and their tutor watch the Spanish version of the vocabulary and grammar video together. Then, students must complete two engaging extension activities: ***Mi cuarto ideal* and *Redacción: Así es mi cuarto ideal***, which will allow them to create projects that can be shared with their classmates or family to show the Spanish knowledge gained up to this point. Each activity includes its corresponding rubric. It is a valuable resource than can also be used for homework.


##### ¡Comenzamos!

**Title: Mi cuarto ideal**

**Outcome: A poster with a detailed design of “My ideal room”**

**Materials:**

a big piece of cardboard or paper  
pencil  
colored pencils, crayons, and/or markers

**Follow these steps below to create your poster. Use the rubric at the end of this activity to make sure your work is complete.**

- You will first decide the size of the room and how you will use the space. There should be separate areas for different activities (sleeping, studying, watching TV, playing videogames, chilling out and having a snack with your friends) and things (your figurine/miniature car collection, trophies/medals, a mini chemistry lab). Will your room have large windows? A charming skylight? You can include anything you want!  
Begin by drawing the floor in the center of the cardboard or paper—you should leave enough space around the drawing to add specific details later. Show the placement of windows and doors; distribute and mark different areas and bigger pieces of furniture.  
Label each different area and element in your blueprint. Make sure to include an article or a possessive adjective for each item. For example:  
**la ventana**  
**mi cama**
- Add details for specific areas that are especially important for you by drawing an arrow from that place or item to a bubble or a square in the margin of the drawing. Inside the bubble or square, show in detail what there is and how each thing is arranged. You may draw the textile design for curtains, bedspread, pillows, carpets or the computer/multimedia corner with the latest technology. You may decide to make your room soundproof so that you can practice with your drum set. You may even draw open closets and chest drawers and show what is inside. Remember, it’s your dream! Use colors to make your poster more appealing.
