Welcome to Wisewire Education Marketplace, a searchable database of high-quality learning objects for educators to easily access the best materials, both free and paid, to supplement lesson planning and assessment. Our site can be used to discover learning content and to create, sell, share, and assign technology-enhanced assessments.

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1. Searching, Filtering and Exploring the Marketplace

Search Wisewire.com by entering a topic in the search box on the homepage, or by opening the magnifying glass tool in the site header.



After entering a search topic you may select any applicable filters in the left pane to narrow your search results. Browse the results in their entirety by using the rank feature or the page results at the bottom. Use the “View” buttons to change how results are displayed.

Select a search tile to view the learning object detail page as shown below. All visitors can search and browse the marketplace and preview content. Related learning objects will appear at the bottom of the screen when applicable. If an object is part of a series you will see “Next” and “Previous” buttons above the title.


2.2. After you have logged in, you will now see a personalized homepage. Scroll to see your recently viewed items, as well as what is trending under “What People Are Viewing.”




5. Using the Create Platform

To enter the assessment platform to create and assign resources to your students, select “Hi, Your Name” from the site header and then “My Dashboard.”



Within the platform you will be able to retrieve any item or assessment purchases you have made in the marketplace under “Your Items.” Recall that free learning objects added from the marketplace will be available here as well, but under “Your Favorites.” You now are also able to create your own items and assessments and assign to student groups.







5.1. Cloning and Editing Questions

The clone function allows you to make a copy of an existing question, edit it as you wish, and publish it as a new item.

5.1.1. To clone a question, navigate to the question you would like to clone under “Your Activity.” We have also provided 12 sample questions in various templates for your convenience under “Resources.” Currently, only individual questions (not assessments) can be cloned.



Select the downward arrow next to the gear icon to open the menu and select “Clone Question.”




An editable authoring template will open with the information from the existing item. Change the title, question, answer options, interactive elements, solution, hint, and feedback for the cloned item as you wish by deleting and adding information to each field as needed. 
Select “Publish” to complete your item so that it can be added to an assessment. Then, enter any necessary metadata and select “Update.” You can find your cloned items in the “Created by You” section beneath “Your Activity” in the dashboard.

5.2. Creating an Assessment

5.2.1. An assessment is a collection of questions. To create a draft assessment, navigate to the first question you wish to include. Select the downward arrow next to the gear to the right of the question and select “Add Question to Assessment.”



If this is the first time you have created an assessment, select “new draft Assessment” in the pop-up box that appears.



If you have previously created assessments and are adding questions to one, a list of the available draft assessments will appear with corresponding check boxes. Check the box next to the assessment you are modifying.



To create a new draft assessment, add a title and description and select “Create Assessment.”






You can re-order questions by renumbering them in the “#” column or by selecting and dragging them to the left of their numbers. You also can add appropriate categories and metadata by selecting from the menu or checking off the appropriate boxes as shown below. This will help you use the search feature as your item library grows.

5.2.3. Select “Publish Assessment” in the lower right corner to make your assessment accessible to others. They will need to have the URL for the assessment in order to view it, or be a member of a group that you’ve assigned it to in order to take the assessment.



5.2.4 Wisewire integrates multiple shortcuts for you to share the assessment URL with others for non-recorded student practice or perhaps for feedback from your colleagues. Use the “Share This Assessment” links that are visible on the published assessment to share your creations with others without formally assigning them.

5.3. Assigning Assessments

5.3.1. To assign an assessment to a student or student group, select “Assign an Assessment” beneath “Your Assignments” on the left side of the dashboard.

5.3.2. If you have not yet created a group to assign the assessment to, select “Create New Group” from the drop-down menu that appears in the pop-up box. If you wish to assign the assessment to an existing group, select that group.

5.4. The Student Experience

Students must have an account at platform.wisewire.com in order to receive assignments and have their results recorded. If you have added a student email to a group they will receive an email alert of the assignment, and be prompted to sign up if they have not already.

5.4.1. To sign up, students must visit platform.wisewire.com/signup and enter a name, email, and password.

After signing up, students will automatically see any assignments from you if they registered with the same email that you added to a group.

5.4.2. If they do not see the assignment, they can enter the group code you provide in the purple “Join Group” box and select “Submit.”





After entering a valid group code they will see a pop-up message similar to the below.

5.4.4. Students can access all of their assignments received by selecting “Assignments Received” in the left nav of their dashboard. They can sort their assignments by date, title, or % correct.

5.4.6. The system allows for two attempts of each question and, if present in the items, gives targeted feedback to the student based on their response or a complete solution when the answer is correct. Otherwise just a “Try Again” button will appear.

The median is the middle value when the data values are written in order from least to greatest.

Write the values in order: 34, 44, 56, 78, 79, 82

There is an even number of data values, so the median is the mean of the two middle values: $\frac{56 + 78}{2} = \frac{134}{2} = 67$.

Adding another data value to the set would result in an odd number of data values, so the median of the new set is the middle value. The new data value must be equal to the median of the original set, 67.

The student may also see up to two hints which are scaffolded to assist with practice and remediation. Hint 2 will only be viewable after Hint 1 is selected.




5.9. Publishing Platform Content to the Marketplace


