

Adding and Subtracting Fractions with Unlike Denominators

(5.NF.A.1)

To add or subtract fractions you may first need to create **equivalent fractions**. An equivalent fraction is created when both the numerator and denominator are multiplied or divided by the same number. In order to add or subtract fraction the denominators must be the same.

Misconception #1: Add or subtract as if the numerator and denominator are separate numbers:
